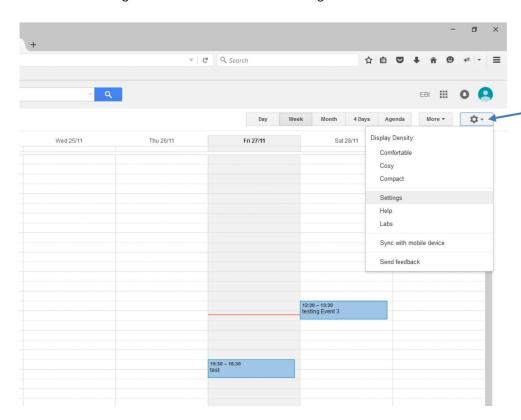
Overview

Setting up your calendar for sharing

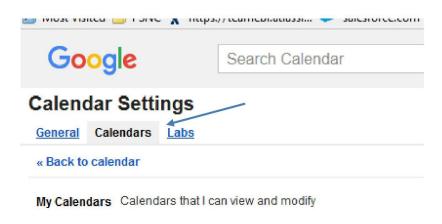
In order for your calendar to display on your site you will need to make your calendar public. To do this first login to: https://calendar.google.com

Select the settings icon and then click on settings:



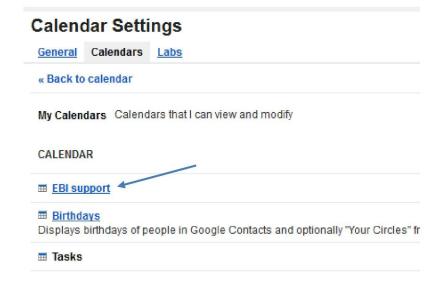

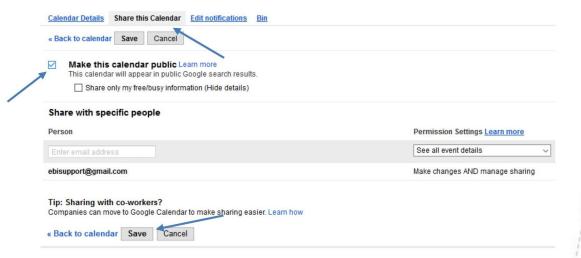
Click on the calendar you wish to share:





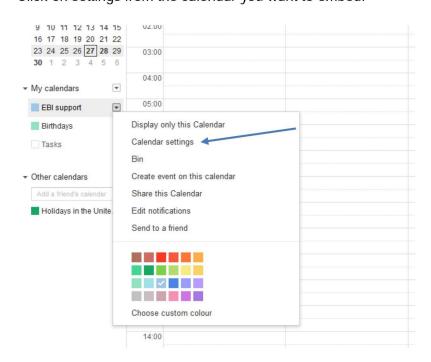

Click the Share This calendar menu and then tick "make this calendar public" and save:



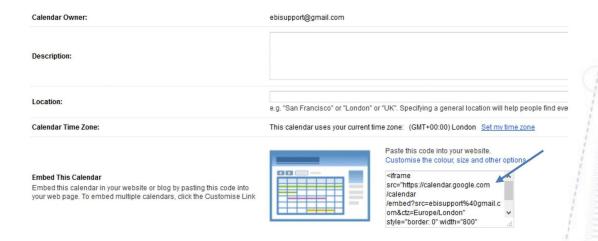
Where to find the code to embed your Google Calendar:

Click on settings from the calendar you want to embed:

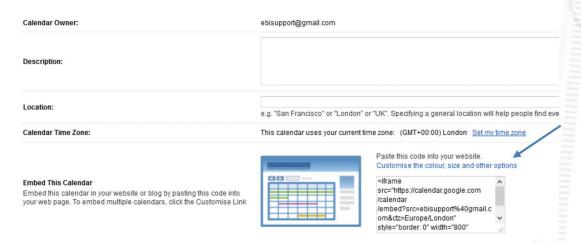




You can then copy the Embed this Calendar Code onto any page on your site:

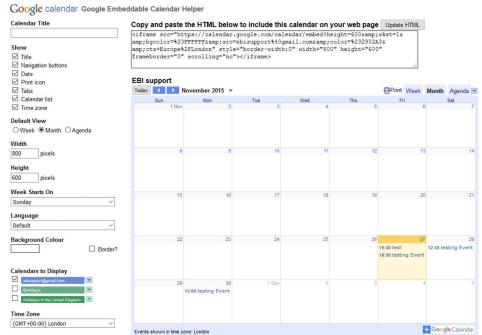


You can customise the look and functionality of your calendar by clicking on the Customise the colour, size and other options link:





This will take you to a new page where you can then begin to edit your calendar, Copy and paste the HTML code onto any page in your site:



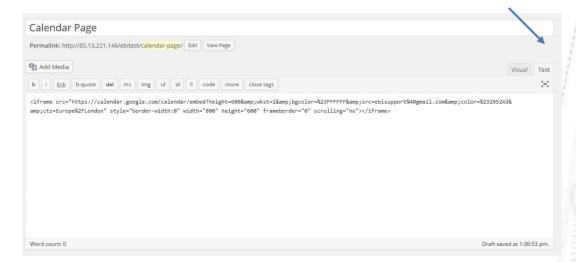

You can embed the calendar onto any page you choose, login to your LPC site admin area and select the page you want the calendar to display on.

 Paste the code copied from your Google calendar onto the page, be sure to change to Text view before your paste your code in:





• Save and publish the page and your calendar will then be visible:



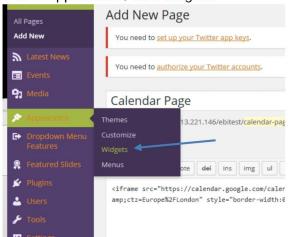

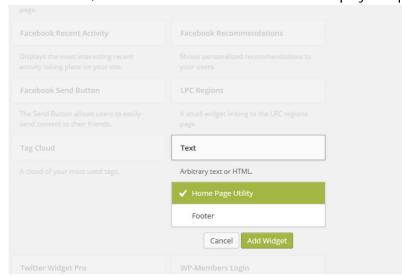
Embedding your Calendar into a widget on your home page

You can also embed your calendar in a widget which can then appear at the bottom of your home page.

• Select Appearance, then widgets:

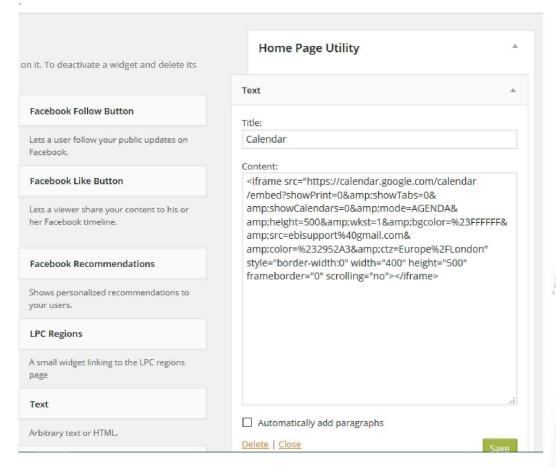


• Click on Text, then choose the location for this to display and press Add Widget:

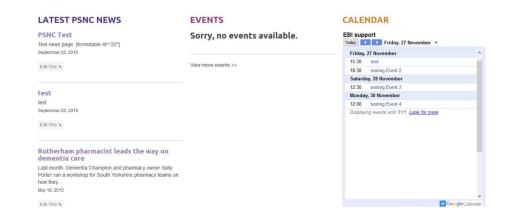




Enter in a name for your widget and paste in the code from your Google calendar and save:



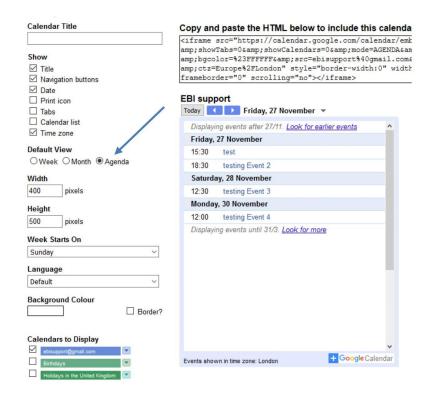
This will now appear on your home page:





• Due to the limited space in a widget, it is recommended that you only choose to use the agenda view here, this can be set by customising your calendar in your calendar settings before you copy the HTML code:

The recommended Width and height when using the calendar in a widget is:

Width: 400 Height: 500

It is also recommended that you un-tick the Tabs option as well, this will then stop the user from changing the view of the calendar on your home page.
